
#### Finding a Balance with the Right Products

What employee surveys and research tell us is that every employee is different, and they all work best in different environments. # SEPARATE. DON'T ISOLATE.

There is a key difference between separation and isolation in the office. One can be a healthy and productive way for employees to operate; the other is damaging to productivity and employee wellness.

Research on the topic of private workstations has one key takeaway: employees are twice as productive when their visual privacy is protected, hinting towards a necessity for space division products. On the other side of the equation, employees, when surveyed, have made it clear they are not happy trapped in isolated offices or cubicles. 5

The ideal compromise is space division products that offer enough visual privacy without instilling a sense of isolation. There are two major productivity and wellness benefits of workspaces that are separated, rather than isolated:

- 1. Employees within their workspace feel less constricted and closed off.
- 2. Coworkers have partial visibility of one another, which lets each person know when they can and cannot interrupt a person who is working.
